1.	Call to Order	The meeting was called to order by President, Jerry Davis.
2.	Pledge of Allegiance	All in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

4.	Audience	Tyler Karney – Mr. Karney stated that he was speaking on behalf of the vocational agriculture advisory committee in regards to Tim Provost, High School vocational agriculture teacher. He expressed their gratitude to the Board for their support in hiring Mr. Provost. The advisory committee feels that Crowley County is known for its program and it has grown tremendously since Mr. Provost started. Mr. Karney stated that Mr. Provost is being sought after by other districts because of his success here at Crowley County. Mr. Karney and the advisory committee asked the Board to consider different options to help Mr. Provost stay in our district. They suggest letting him use the Vo-Ag pick-up to drive at all times instead of just at work only, increasing his extra duty pay as the FFA sponsor, or increasing the percentage Mr. Provost gets paid on the schedule. Mr. Karney stated that they understand many teachers work just as hard and give extra time so they feel that raising the base salary on the extra duty would benefit more than just Mr. Provost.
